

Hello Union Family!

WOW OH WOW!!!!!! The generosity of each and every one of you here...!'m lost for words every time I think of what God has done through all of you as His vessels. All I can say is, **THANK YOU ALL!** None of the things that I've been able to get done could have been done without everyone's collective support.

I have even more excellent news to report to you about the lighting project. The company that we have contracted to complete the light system overhaul has us scheduled to be done in time for service on Palm Sunday (Sunday, March 24th). They have already been ordering all the hardware and parts needed to complete the installation ahead of time, and the install will be performed from Wednesday, March 20th through Friday, March 22nd. I look forward to being able to fully reveal all parts of the stage (especially for those who watch us live) and showing how I can use this new system to invite an atmosphere of worship and praise on a whole new level.

We were also able to complete an expansion to our Wi-Fi network out to our portables and the garage. This will enable us to provide a stable connection to the internet for our groups that meet out in Portable 1 and for larger community events held over on that part of the campus.

In addition, we have been doing some work with our Servant Keeper Membership Database; expanding on functionality that hasn't been fully leveraged, such as an online accessible Member Directory (for those registered with us only), and easier means for our members to update their information online. More information will become available as we roll out these features and functions.

Also, we are going to be introducing a new way to connect with us! We have created an easy access link to information about Union Church with LinkTree! It works like this: There is a scannable QR barcode that will be attached to this article, along with upcoming media that we release. Use your camera app on your modern smart device (Android or Apple – Smartphones or Tablets) and it will highlight the barcode. You can then tap on the link that is provided and it will connect you into LinkTree, which will have several fast access links to our Social Media (Facebook and Instagram), YouTube Streams (view livestream and watch messages), our Church Website, and our FaithStreet Online Giving portal. If you have any questions on how to use this, feel free to contact me. This is pretty simple once you see it used once. So, if you have anyone you want to share about our ministries or give them an easy way to connect with us, you can show the QR code to your friends and family and they can scan it for all the info they need!

Again, I want to thank every one of you for contributing to these needed projects as they couldn't have been completed without your support. I also want to thank each and every one of my tech volunteers and our staff members who help support me with being able to keep our operations running smoothly. I truly am excited for what God has in store for us in 2024 and look forward to seeing what He has to reveal to us.

FRESH WIND

As Winter comes to an end and Spring is on the horizon, I look back in awe and gratitude of all God has done in and through Union in the last few months. His provision has exceeded our expectations and has made way for yet another divine shift in the energy here. I felt this way a few years ago when I witnessed how God brought us through the pandemic, accelerated our ability to reduce our debt, and made us a stronger vessel for His Kingdom.

With the new life that Spring brings, I feel a fresh wind circulating here at Union. There's an excitement that comes from seeing God's plan for us unfold. As we remain committed stewards of His financial provision, we're closing in on our debt, which now stands at \$95,550. We are hopeful that this year will be the year that we will be able to say, "It is finished!" This fresh wind gives way to new hope for the perfect plans and purpose God has in store for us. It gives way to a fresh perspective of our vision for the future. A future where we are no longer burdened by debt and free to invest even more in Union's Kingdom building dreams.

We prayed bold prayers and believed for God's blessing over our fundraising efforts for our Christmas Match and our stage lighting project. He used all of you in a mighty way; exceeding the goals we set for each and proving that He is more than able to do far more than we can ask, think, or imagine. Our Christmas Match brought in \$82,172, which helped us to pay down our debt, subsidize our weekly offerings, and enter the new year with all bills paid in full. You then came through when the call was put out for an expensive necessary stage lighting project, exceeding the goal by \$1,630. And now we're boldly trusting God and our faithful congregation for another miracle as we prepare for our Easter Match. These funds not only help us to reduce the debt, they also help us get through the summer months when our Snowbirds go back North, and the weekly offerings drop significantly. Last year's Easter Match brought in \$50,080 and we believe God will, once again, show up and show out!

This year is off to an amazing start, and we thank you for all you have done to help bring about this fresh wind. We also thank you in advance for the ways you will be used in this new season. You are a blessing to Union and may God bless you all beyond measure.


Vision Statement
